

Outside of London in England the top universities are located in Durham, Birmingham, Manchester, Liverpool, Exeter, Leeds, Sheffield, Bristol, York, Nottingham, Kent, Bath, Loughborough, Newcastle, Southampton and Warwick. Scotland has its own semi-separate educational system, with universities in Aberdeen (Aberdeen and Robert Gordon), Dundee (Dundee and Abertay), Edinburgh (Edinburgh, Napier, Queen Margaret, and Heriot-Watt), Glasgow (Glasgow, Strathclyde, and Caledonian), Stirling, and St Andrews.

Healthcare

In case of healthcare emergency, you can call the local emergency telephone number 999 or the EU-wide 112.

All emergency treatment is free, regardless of citizenship or immigration status. This also applies to tourists, both from the EU and outside. Emergencies can be dealt with under the NHS at any hospital with a Casualty or Accident & Emergency (A & E) department. Emergencies are dealt with immediately, even before any question of remuneration is contemplated.

For advice on non-emergency medical problems, you can ring the 24-hour National Health Service (NHS) on 111.

Walk-in centres also provide treatment for less urgent conditions on a first come first served basis. They are open to residents and foreign nationals. All treatment at an NHS hospital or doctor is free to residents of the UK.

Other things to keep in mind when you come for the Immigrants visa health check up:

- Bring your original passport with 3 photocopies and a photocopy of all your past and present medical records, medicines, prescriptions, vaccination (if any), eye glasses (if worn) records
- There are no food restrictions. You do not need to come fasting.
- Come with prior appointment to avoid waiting time
- All the procedures may take upto 3-4 hours
- Pregnant applicants have the option to undergo chest x-ray with protective gear (double lead shield covering of the abdomen) or can defer medical exam until post delivery. Applicant has to check with their gynaecologist before coming for the medicals regarding the above.
